CUSTOMS ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 1-2001

SUBJECT: RATES OF CUSTOMS BROKERAGE FEES

Pursuant to the provision of Section 651 of the Revised Administrative Code and Section 608 of the Tariff and Customs Code of the Philippines (TCCP), as amended by Presidential Decree No. 1464, the rates of Customs Brokerage Fees charged by Customs Brokers and Brokerage Firms in all ports of the Philippines shall be, as follows:

I. *Formal/Warehousing Entries and Transshipment.* For services rendered to clear shipments covered by Formal/Warehousing Entries and Transshipment:

III. *Export Declarations.* For services rendered to clear shipments covered by export declarations, *one-half* of the new rates specified under the preceding Paragraph I.

IV. *Other Services.* For other services, specifically, in relation to --

MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT : CAO ON CUSTOMS BROKERAGE FEES

DATE : 27 April 2001

Forwarded for approval is a Customs Administrative Order (CAO) on the new Customs Brokerage Fees as signed by the Commissioner.

This new schedule, initially proposed by various brokerage organizations, was subsequently discussed in a series of meetings with members of the Port Users Confederation (PUC), the umbrella organization of 22 industry groups representing the trading community. PUC, in turn, endorsed the new rates to the Bureau.

The PUC endorses the new rates in view of the increasing administrative, operational and other costs of brokerage business. (Please see Annex A.)

The last adjustments in the Customs brokerage fees were established through CAO 3-96 as may be gleaned from Annex B hereof, which also shows in a matrix the percentage difference between the existing rates and the new rates.

The new rates take effect fifteen days from approval and publication of the CAO.
