CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER
NO. 86-91

To: All District/Port Collectors
All Service/Division Chiefs
and All Others Concerned

Subject: Delegation of Authority to District Collector
of Customs amending CMO 68-91

I. OBJECTIVES:

1. To further delegate the authority of the Commissioner of Customs to approve extension of storage period pursuant to Section 2002, of the TCCP, as amended.
2. To avoid delay in the approval of request for extension of storage period.

II. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

1. Request for extension of storage period of raw materials prescribed in Section 2002 of the TCCP, as amended, shall originate from the Operator thru the Chief, Customs Bonded Warehouse Operating Division, with the examination report of the WAD Customs Examiner or its equivalent unit.
2. The District Collector of Customs shall submit a weekly report to the Commissioner of Customs on actions taken on matters pertaining to the delegated authority. The report shall include a clean copy of the accomplished Disposition Form and implementing indorsements, memoranda or letters/ as the case may be.

The authority of the Commissioner of Customs to allow an extension of three (3) months storage period for raw materials to be re-exported is hereby delegated to the District Collector of Customs, who shall approve said request and shall sign as follows:
