





"JEBCHEM 1009M AQ"

Based on the technical data sheet, safety data sheet, product composition, and other technical information submitted, subject article is a non-ionic surface-active preparation composed of mineral oil, aluminum stearate, and polyoxyethylene glycol monoleate. It is in the form of a grey-white to light-yellow liquid. Packed in 25-L carboys, 200-L plastic drums, and in intermediate bulk containers, subject article is used as a defoaming agent in the production of water-based coatings, inks, and adhesives.
