This has reference to the reform initiatives of the Anti-Red Tape Authority (ARTA) for Trading Across Borders (TAB) indicator of the Doing Business Report to be submitted for the consideration of the World Bank. The TAB Reform Committee conducted a meeting on 20 May 2021. During the said meeting, ARTA requested for a data in relation to the number of importers and exporters who availed of the Provisional Goods Declaration (PGD).

In view thereof, you are hereby directed to submit a report on the following:

- a. list of all importers and exporters who availed of the PGD
- b. importers of commodities under HS 8708: Parts and accessories of motor vehicles with JAPAN as its trade partner; and
- c. list of exporters of HS 85: Electrical Machinery and equipment, and parts thereof with Hong Kong SAR as its trade partner.

Said reports shall cover the period of May 1, 2020 to April 30 2021.
