SUBJECT : USE OF THE TRADENET PLATFORM BY THE BUREAU OF
AGRICULTURAL AND FISHERIES STANDARDS (BAFS)

With reference to the attached letter dated 28 July 2021 addressed to the Secretary of the Department of Finance (DOF), copy furnished the Commissioner, Bureau of Customs (BOC) from Dr. Myer G. Mula, Director, Bureau of Agriculture and Fisheries Standards, Department of Agriculture (BAFS-DA), please be informed that the BAFS-DA is ready to use the Tradenet Platform (Tradenet.gov.ph) to process Import and Export Permits for organic inputs (soil amendments and biocontrol agents).

The following five (5) pilot users were initially trained on the use of the platform last 27 July 2021:

- Radialpro Trading Incorporated;
- Oracle Chem Corporation;
- Aktive Multi-Trading Co. Phils., Inc.;
- Agway Chemicals Corporation; and
- Stockton Agrimor Phils., Inc

In the meantime, the rest of the stakeholders will still use the manual system for Import and Export Permit applications but will eventually migrate to the Tradenet System in due time.

Moreover, while the Organic Input Importation and Exportation Permit is in electronic form, it should be noted that the same does not preclude the presentation and acceptance of a manually prepared amended permit in cases allowed by rules.

Dear Secretary Dominguez:

This is to respectfully inform your good office that the Bureau of Agriculture and Fisheries Standards (BAFS) is ready to use the Tradenet Platform (Tradenet.gov.ph) to process Import and Export Permits for organic inputs (soil amendments and biocontrol agents).

Initially, five (5) pilot users were trained on the use of the platform last July 27, 2021, namely:

1. Radialpro Trading Incorporated
2. Oracle Chem Corporation
3. Aktive Multi- Trading Co. Phils., Inc.
4. Agway Chemicals Corporation
5. Stockton Agrimor Phils., Inc.

In the meantime, the rest of the stakeholders will still use the manual system for Import and Export Permit applications, but will eventually migrate to the **Tradenet System** in due time.

Please note that while the Organic Input Importation and Exportation Permit is in electronic form, this does not preclude the presentation and acceptance of a manually prepared amended permit, in cases allowed by the rules. We also attach for your reference the activity diagrams of the modified procedures for the import and export applications that are EODB compliant in the said platform.

We recognize the important and indispensable role of the Bureau of Customs (BOC) in the claiming and utilization of the aforementioned Organic Input Importation and Exportation Permits within the Tradenet System (Tradenet.gov.ph). The online, real-time, and immutable nature of the feedback regarding the said claiming and utilization will provide the BAFS with a more efficient way to monitor and document the use of these permits.
