Importation of Basic Oxygen Furnace (BOF) cement additive

Attached is a copy of the letter dated March 1, 2019 of Engr. Metodio U. Turbella, Director, Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) – Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), copy furnished the Bureau of Customs thru the Chief, Environmental Protection Unit-Enforcement and Security Service (EPU-ESS), stating therein that the importation of Basic Oxygen Furnace (BOF) cement additive in slag form is not allowed and that slag can only be imported for purposes of further refining or reprocessing as provided in Table 10.1 of DENR Administrative Order (DAO) 2013-22, entitled, "Revised Procedures and Standards for the Management of Hazardous Wastes" (Revising DAO 2004-36).



It is noted that the said material will be used as ten percent (10%) component for cement production. Please be reminded that if the material is in the form of slag, its importation is not allowed. Slag can only be imported for purposes of further refining or reprocessing as provided in Table 10.1 of DENR Administrative Order (DAO) 2013-22, entitled, "Revised Procedures and Standards for the Management of Hazardous Wastes (Revising DAO 2004-36).

In this regard, we regret to inform that we cannot favorably grant your request to import such material.
