Dear Commissioner Lapeña:

This has reference to the request of our SRA Registered International Sugar Traders in good standing to expedite the release of their imported sugar, in line with our agency's importation program as stated in Sugar Order # 10 Series of 2017-2018 due to tightness of supply and price affordability.

We were informed by our traders that some of their shipments have been alerted by the Office of the Commissioner due to "Suspected Misdeclarations in Volume". This is one of the reasons of the delays in the release of their imported sugar resulting to additional storage and demurrage fees for the importers.

In this connection, we would like to request on their behalf to fast track the assessments and examinations that need to be done in order to lift the Alert Orders issued by the OCOM.

We are providing you a list of registered international sugar traders/importers with their shipment's Port of Entries who have been given Alert Orders.

Attached also is the List of traders for Crop Year 2017-2018 with import allocation. The said list of international sugar traders are allowed to import sugar and a Clearance for Release of Imported Sugar is issued following the requirements for the subject importation.
