**Subject: Implementation of Disaster Resilience Measures  
Nationwide**

Attached is a copy of the Cabinet Action/Decision File No. 584-010719-34 regarding the implementation of disaster resilience measures nationwide.

Hereunder are the DOST's proposals and/or measures which were approved by the cabinet:

- Review and/or develop hazard and risk sensitive land use plans;
- Craft community-based preparedness involving local government units (LGUs) and residents, with protocols for preparedness and response;
- Build capacity of LGUs through information dissemination;
- Establish redundant communication system down to the communities and involvement of local broadcast media especially radio;
- Craft hazard and risk sensitive infrastructure plans, e.g. schools, hospitals, government facilities, to consider climate change and the consequence of altering the natural environment;
- Mainstream risk reduction or climate change adaptation in national and local development plans;
- Continue Improvement of monitoring systems;
- Strengthen resilience of urban areas such as Metro Manila, Metro Cebu, Davao, Iloilo especially for sudden onset events like earthquakes; and
- Implement the Greater Metro Manila Resiliency action plans.
