The DOLE-DTI Joint Department Order No. 1, s. 2017 is intended to ensure compliance to labor laws of garments exporters availing of the preferential tariff under EU-GSP+ by requiring them to apply for accreditation with the DTI Accrediting Board (DAB). Under the Joint Department Order, accreditation is mandatory for those availing of the preferential tariff and voluntary for those who do not avail of the same. For this purpose, the said Joint Department Order created the Workers' Rights Review Committee (WRRC) which findings and recommendations, upon the conduct of audit of the applicant's compliance to labor standards, will be the basis of DAB in granting or denying the accreditation. The WRRC is governed by a separate Internal Rules signed on 8 August 2018 by DOLE Undersecretary Joel B. Maglunsod, DTI Undersecretary Rowel S. Barba, and sectoral representatives in the National Clothing and Textile Industry Tripartite Council (CTITC).

One of the undertakings of the National CTITC to ensure the effective implementation of DOLE-DTI Joint Department Order No. 1, s. 2017 and its Internal Rules is the conduct of orientations in regions where the garments exporters are concentrated. In order to determine the priority areas where the orientations shall be held, may we respectfully request for the following:

- 1. List of garments manufacturers, exporters, and subcontractors exporting to Europand their respective place of operation; and
- List of garments manufacturers, exporters, and subcontractors exporting to Europe
 that are availing of or currently applying for the preferential tariff under the
 Generalized System of Preference.

We will appreciate receiving the requested data on or before 30 April 2019 in time for the second quarterly meeting of the National CTITC in May.
