Pursuant to Sections 1220 and 1224 of R.A. 10863, otherwise known as the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA), aircraft arriving in the Philippines from any foreign port or place which shall make its first landing at a non-international port of entry, including its departure therefrom should first obtain permission or clearance from the Bureau of Customs' Commissioner.

In relation thereto, the Office of the Commissioner hereby reminds all concerned airports that the request for the issuance of the Special Landing Permit (SLP) shall only cover the circumstances as stated above. International Airports shall, therefore, comply with Sections 1219-1225 of the CMTA and other related laws on the requirements and procedures for aircraft arrival and departure from and to a foreign port or place.
