SUBJECT : ENJOINING THE DEPARTMENT SECRETARIES AND AGENCY HEADS TO SUPPORT THE OPPAP/GOVERNMENT PANEL IN THE PEACE NEGOTIATIONS AND PEACE ENGAGEMENTS
DATE : 09 January 2017

Bearing in mind that the achievement of a permanent and lasting peace is a priority of the President, you are hereby directed to extend utmost technical and logistical support to the Office of the Presidential Adviser on the Peace Process and to the Government Negotiating Panels in the discharge of their work relative to the peace negotiations and peace agreement implementation, particularly in connection with the on-going peace talks with the Communist Party of the Philippines, New People's Army, National Democratic Front, and the implementation of peace and development engagements with the Moro National Liberation Front, Moro Islamic Liberation Front and other sectors.

In this regard, you are also hereby enjoined to designate the department/agency's representative or resource person to the working committees and other groups created as may be deemed necessary by the Panel Chairpersons in the furtherance of the peace negotiations and peace agreement implementation. All costs of said representative or resource person in relation thereto shall be assumed by the concerned Department/Agency.
