Attached is a letter dated 07 November 2016 from Mr. Ramon M. Lopez, Secretary, Department of Trade and Industry to Secretary Carlos G. Dominguez, Department of Finance, furnishing copies of their Order and Report on the Preliminary Determination of the anti-dumping petition against the importation of clear and bronze float glass from the **People's Republic of China (PROC)** which quotes:

*"Pursuant to Section 8 of RA 8752 and its IRR, the Secretary shall immediately issue through the Secretary of Finance, written instructions to the Commissioner of Customs to impose within three (3) days from receipt of instructions, the provisionally estimated anti-dumping duty in the form of a **cash bond** in the amount of **US\$44.55/MT to US\$142.23/MT** on imported **clear float glass** classified under **AHTN Code 7005.2990** and **US\$23.06/MT to US\$104.09/MT** on imported **bronze float glass** classified under **AHTN Code 7005.2190** originating from **PROC** for a period of four (4) month from the effectivity of the Order i.e from the date of issuance of the relevant Customs Memorandum Order or fifteen (15) days after the publication of the Order in two (2) newspapers of general circulation, whichever comes earlier."*

The dispositive portion of the Order reads:

*In view thereof, the corresponding provisional anti-dumping duty in the form of a cash bond will be imposed for a period of four (4) months from the effectivity of this Order on importation of clear and bronze float glass originating from PROC.*


We are furnishing you copies of the Department of Trade and Industry's Order and Report on the Preliminary Determination of the anti-dumping petition against the importation of clear and bronze float glass from the People's Republic of China (PROC).

Pursuant to Section 8 of RA 8752 and its IRR, the Secretary shall immediately issue through the Secretary of Finance, written instructions to the Commissioner of Customs to impose within three (3) days from receipt of instructions, the provisionally estimated anti-dumping duty in the form of a cash bond in the amount of US\$44.55/MT to US\$142.23/MT on imported clear float glass classified under AHTN Code 7005.2990 and US\$23.06/MT to US\$104.09/MT on imported bronze float glass classified under AHTN Code 7005.2190 originating from PROC for a period of four (4) months from the effectivity of the Order i.e. from the date of issuance of the relevant Customs Memorandum Order or fifteen (15) days after the publication of the Order in two (2) newspapers of general circulation, whichever comes earlier.

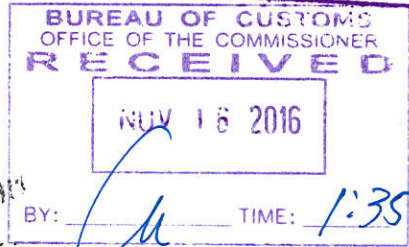
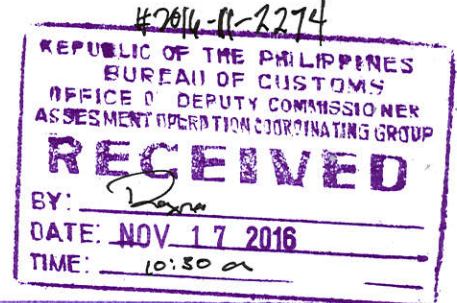

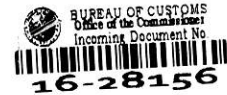

**ORDER**

An anti-dumping petition was filed by AGC Flat Glass Philippines, Inc. (AGPH) formerly Asahi Glass Philippines Inc. against importation of clear float glass and bronze float glass from People's Republic of China (PROC). The protest alleged that clear float glass and bronze float glass are being imported from PROC at dumped prices and that as a result thereof causes material injury to the domestic industry producing like product.

The period of investigation for dumping or price difference for this petition covered import transactions for the period January to December 2015. However, for the injury determination, the period of investigation considered relevant information for the four (4) year period, i.e. 2012 to 2015.

The Department of Trade and Industry acting under paragraph f of Section 301 of the Tariff and Customs Code, as amended by RA 8752, found after preliminary determination, an affirmative finding of dumping on the anti-dumping petition filed by AGPH against clear and bronze float glass from PROC.

**IN VIEW THEREOF**, the corresponding provisional anti-dumping duty in the form of a cash bond will be imposed for a period of four (4) months from the effectivity of this Order on importation of clear and bronze float glass originating from PROC. (Annex A)

**ORDER**

An anti-dumping petition was filed by AGC Flat Glass Philippines, Inc. (AGPH) formerly Asahi Glass Philippines Inc. against importation of clear float glass and bronze float glass from People's Republic of China (PROC). The protest alleged that clear float glass and bronze float glass are being imported from PROC at dumped prices and that as a result thereof causes material injury to the domestic industry producing like product.

The period of investigation for dumping or price difference for this petition covered import transactions for the period January to December 2015. However, for the injury determination, the period of investigation considered relevant information for the four (4) year period, i.e. 2012 to 2015.

The Department of Trade and Industry acting under paragraph f of Section 301 of the Tariff and Customs Code, as amended by RA 8752, found after preliminary determination, an affirmative finding of dumping on the anti-dumping petition filed by AGPH against clear and bronze float glass from PROC.

**IN VIEW THEREOF**, the corresponding provisional anti-dumping duty in the form of a cash bond will be imposed for a period of four (4) months, from the effectivity of this Order on importation of clear and bronze float glass originating from PROC. (Annex A)

The petition will be forwarded to the Tariff Commission for formal investigation to determine whether or not there is a need to impose a definitive anti-dumping duty.

This Order shall take effect upon the issuance of the relevant Memorandum Order by the Bureau of Customs or fifteen (15) days after the publication of this Order in two (2) newspapers of general circulation, whichever comes earlier.

Let this Order be published in two (2) newspapers of general circulation and let individual notices be sent to all interested parties including the country member concerned.
