
Subject : Non-Compliance with existing rules
on processing of PDIG.

It has been brought to our attention that PERMITS TO DELIVER IMPORTED GOODS (PDIG) which have been verified and processed with the INWARD CARGO MANIFEST by the MARINE DIVISION and approved for delivery by the Formal Entry Division are again re-processed with the cargo manifest when the PDIG is transmitted to the piers thru the Pier Inspection Division (PID) for actual delivery.

This procedure is not allowed by any of our policy of trade facilitation. Besides, it causes delay and have been the subject of numerous complaints by the port users.

Henceforth, you are hereby enjoined to immediately stop this unauthorized practice and anyone not complying with this Order will be dealt with accordingly.
