CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER

Subject: Importations of Motor Vehicle Parts and Machinery Parts

To: All Collectors of Customs  
Service/Division Chiefs  
Customs Appraisers/Examiners  
All Others Concerned

For effective control and in order to safeguard government revenue, all importations of motor vehicle parts and machinery parts, except those covered by SGS Clean Report of Findings, shall be subject to 100% examination prior to their release.

All documents relative thereto shall be submitted, using the attached form, to the Office of the Commissioner for clearance before effecting release.

Customs Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 85-90 is hereby modified but only insofar as the delegated authority of the Deputy Commissioner for Assessment and Operations to grant clearance for shipments under CMO No. 74-88 (Used Truck Replacement Parts) is concerned.

Any Memorandum, Customs Memorandum Orders and other issuances inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

This Order takes effect FEB 14 1991 and shall last until revoked.
