CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER
NO. 10-92


Effective immediately, all releases and/or transfers of shipments from the Security Warehouses of Port of Manila, NAIA and MICP which are classified as abandoned and/or forfeited cargoes disposed thru public auction or by donation, cargoes covered by warrants of seizure and detention or alerted cargoes but subsequently ordered released, by District, Collectors of Customs or higher authorities and unclaimed cargoes declared as abandoned but was reclaimed by legal owners shall be cleared by the Office of the Deputy Commissioner for Intelligence and Enforcement.
