SUBJECT: Implementation of the ACOS Manifest

1.0 OBJECTIVES

- 1.1 To integrate the manifest data into the ACOS clearance process at the ports.
- 1.2 To provide timely and reliable cargo information for the efficient implementation of the automated matching of import declaration and the subsequent issuance of electronic cargo release instruction to the Port Operators.
- 1.3 To further reduce the time for cargo clearance and release by ensuring the correctness of the transport cargo details contained in import declaration against the manifest record used for the Port Operators.

2.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 2.1 All electronic submissions of the cargo manifest shall be in accordance with the new prescribed file formats, herein attached as "**Annex A**", for both shipping lines/agents and seafreight consolidators/forwarders. The new file formats require the use of pre-determined codes and/or values for packaging code, final destination and country of origin. The equivalent codes and/or values are provided in **Annex B** of this Order.
- 2.2 The electronic copy of the inward foreign cargo manifest/consolidation manifest shall be submitted by shipping lines/agents and seafreight consolidators/ forwarders to the Bureau through the facilities of the Port Operators in any of the following means:

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- Electronic Data Interchange (EDI)
- E-mail
- Diskette

The electronic inward cargo manifest shall be submitted immediately upon or before arrival of the carrying vessel while consolidation manifest shall be submitted with five (5) calendar days from the date of arrival of the vessel.

Late submission requires the approval of the Deputy Collector for Operations before acceptance by Port Operator. No late submission via EDI or E-mail will be accepted by the system.

- 2.3 Submission and processing of consolidated cargo manifest requires a corresponding shipping line manifest submission.

In order to facilitate acceptance of consolidation manifest, the concerned consolidator/forwarder should verify first with the shipping line/agent if the corresponding shipping line manifest is already submitted to/registered with the Bureau.

- 2.4 Five (5) critical fields are considered critical for manifest verification purposes. These are –the manifest registry number, bill of lading number, type of packages, quantity and gross weight.
- 2.5 Submission of manifest hard copy shall continue as described in CMO 45-94.

3.0 SUBMISSION OF THE CARGO MANIFEST

- 3.1 Shipping lines/agents and Seafreight consolidators/forwarders shall submit electronic manifest to the Port Operator office.
- 3.2 The Port Operator shall validate the submitted manifest using ACOS to determine whether or not it conforms to the prescribed manifest file specifications.

Successfully validated submissions shall be accordingly process as follows:



3.2.1 For EDI or E-mail Submission – Manifest file shall be automatically uploaded to ACOS for subsequent processing. A successful acknowledgement message shall be generated by ACOS and transmitted to the concerned shipping line/agent or consolidator/forwarders thru the Port Operator via the same transmission facility.

3.2.2 For Diskette Submission – The diskette manifest file shall be immediately returned to the concerned shipping line/agent or consolidator/forwarder with a corresponding acknowledgement message generated by the system on the diskette and an accompanying print-out of the message. Successful validation will automatically trigger uploading of the manifest data to ACOS for subsequent processing.

In cases of unsuccessful validation, the transmitted manifest file/manifest diskette shall be transmitted back/returned to the shipping line/agent or consolidator/forwarder with the error message/s. Based on the error message/s, the shipping line agent or consolidators/forwarder shall make the necessary correction and re-submit/re-transmit the corrected manifest data to Port Operator.

3.3 A manifest file shall be deemed registered with the Bureau on the date and time of its successful registration with ACOS. At that time, it shall be available for entry lodgment.

3.4 The date of last discharge and the date/time of arrival of the vessel shall be encoded by the Pier Inspection Division (PID) thru a computer terminal immediately upon completion of cargo discharging from the vessel.

4. CLEARANCE PROCESS UNDER ACOS MANIFEST MODULE

4.1 During lodgment of entry declaration, matching/verification of the declaration against the manifest is done automatically. Before the entry declaration can be finally registered to ACOS, it should first match with the manifest on the following information:

- Manifest registry number
- Bill of lading number
- For non-bulk cargo – Quantity (as declared in the entry) should be equal to or less than the manifested Quantity

- For bulk cargo – Gross Weight (as declared in the entry) should be equal to or less than the manifested Gross Weight

The result of the verification will be known through the Entry Encoding Center, the Direct Trader Input terminal or EDI facility, depending on what facility the importer/broker used to lodge the declaration.

ACOS shall reject declarations that do not conform to the above matching criteria.

- 4.2 After successful lodgment of the matched declaration in 4.1 above, ACOS shall automatically write-off the manifest details corresponding to the declaration. The written-off manifest will no longer be available for any succeeding entry processing.
- 4.3 For transactions that are not yet processed in ACOS (e.g. transshipment, informal entry, etc.), verification and writing-off of manifest details shall be manually done by the manifest clerk/s of the respective Entry Processing Unit of the concerned office.
- 4.4 The corresponding release instruction shall not be issued to the port operator until the bill of lading covering the shipment has been written-off.

5.5. PROCEDURES IN AMENDING THE CARGO MANIFEST

Based on a approved amendment-to-manifest document, cargo manifest record in ACOS can be amended thru an ACOS computer terminal installed at the office of the Deputy Collector for Operations.

The function of amending manifest in ACOS shall be performed by a personnel duly designated by the District Collector as "ACOS Manifest Amendment Officer"

6.0 REPORTING SYSTEM

ACOS shall generate Urgent Notice to File Entry and Overstaying Cargoes reports in accordance with the requirements prescribed in CMO 45-94.


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7.0 REPEALING CLAUSE

All customs memoranda, orders, or other issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

8.0 EFFECTIVITY

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall last until revoke.
