

Subject: Withholding Deliveries of Shipment Consigned to
**INTERNATIONAL WIRING SYSTEMS
PHILIPPINE CORP.**

In view of the fact that the outstanding accounts of International Wiring Systems Philippine Corp. with the Bureau amounting to ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED THREE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED NINETY S. X PESOS (Php 1,103,696.00) remain unsettled despite repeated demands to settle the same, you are hereby directed to hold the delivery of its present and forthcoming shipments from Customs custody pursuant to Section 1508 of the Tariff and Customs Code of the Philippines, as amended.

This Order shall be made effective immediately and shall last until revoked by another CMO after the settlement of the importer's accounts and a Bureau-wide Certificate of Settlement has been secured from the Collection Service prior to eventual release and/or application of proceeds of sale.

A copy of this Order shall be publicly displayed in the Bulletin Board of all ports of entry and distributed to all concerned for implementation and guidance.
