CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER

To: All District Collectors
Chiefs, Cash Division
and All Others Concerned


Re: Transmittal of Certificate of Payment

In order to cut bureaucratic red tape and avoid delay in the transmittal of Certificate of Payment (CPs) from this Bureau to the Land Transportation Office (LTO), the respective Cash Division of every Collection District, which issues said CPs shall henceforth be the Office exclusively charged in such transmittal.

The Chief, Cash Division, shall designate one of his staff for this purpose, who shall personally deliver the CPs to LTO within 24 hours from the issuance thereof.

This repeals and/or modify Provision No. 6 of CMO 18-92 dated January 29, 1992 and such other orders or memoranda not consistent herewith.

This shall take effect on May 26, 1992 until revoked.
