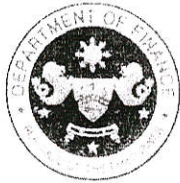

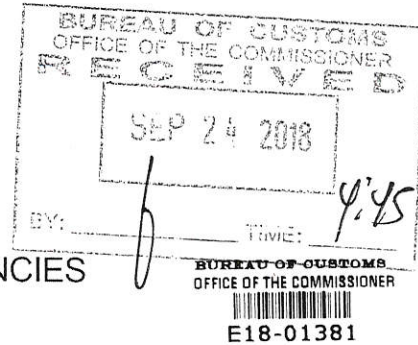

During the 29th Cabinet Meeting held on 11 September 2018 at the Aguinaldo State Dining Room, Malacañan Palace, the Education Secretary stated that when the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation was created, a Presidential Decree was Issued prohibiting government officials from patronizing casinos. The President affirmed that the policy banning all government officials and employees from entering casinos is still in force. He further asserted that government personnel, including **members** of the police force, should not be allowed to moonlight outside casinos and escort high stakes gamblers from the airport.
