AMENDMENT TO CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 06-2014 ENTITLED "REALIGNMENT OF THE X-INSPECTION PROJECT (XIP) TO ENFORCEMENT GROUP AND DESIGNATION OF DUTY CUSTOMS **EXAMINERS** AT THE **DESIGNATED EXAMINATION AREA/FIELD OFFICE BY** THE DISTRICT COLLECTOR", DISCONTINUING THE DESIGNATION AND PRESENCE OF **EXAMINERS AT THE XIP-DEA**

To cut the redundancy of work and to streamline the process of container release, CMO No. 06-2014 dated February 14, 2014 is hereby amended to exclude the following portions:

- 1. 3rd and 4th introductory paragraphs
- 2. Section 2 on the Assignment of Duty Examiners at the XIP Designated Examination Area
- 3. Section 3 on the responsibilities of the Duty Examiner at XIP-DEA
- Section 4 first part, on the presence of Duty Examiner/s during spotchecking at XIP-DEA
- Section 5 on the responsibility of the XIP Field Officer in relation to the presence Duty Examiner/s at XIP-DEA
- Section 6.2 on the responsibility of the Duty Examiner to submit daily report to the District Collector

All other provisions of CMO 06-2014 shall remain effective.

This order shall take effect immediately.
