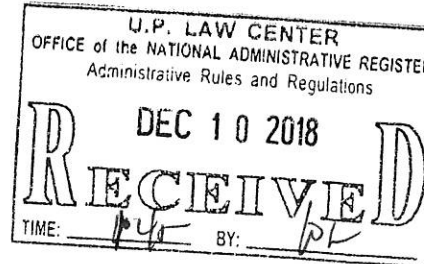



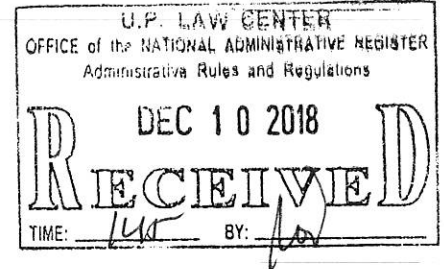

Subject: ACTION ON PENDING ALERT ORDERS AND SPECIAL STOPS


In the exigency of the service, and in order to mitigate the increasing delay in the examination of goods and /or shipments in all districts/ports, covered by pending alert orders and special stops, causing port congestion, unnecessary cost on the part of the government, and economic losses both on the government and private sectors, it is hereby directed that all said pending alerted or specially stopped goods or shipments shall, instead, undergo X-ray examination and spot checking, unless there is reasonable ground after X-ray examination to conduct a complete physical examination for possible violation of the CMTA.

This order shall take effect immediately until revoked.
