To properly monitor the movement, transfer, and clearance of all foreign goods for transshipment, you are hereby directed to submit the following reports using the prescribed templates:

- a. Current Inventory List as of date on the status and exact location of all Transshipment Goods within the container yard from the Customs Facilities Warehouse (CFW) Operator inside the Port using the attached template (**Annex A**);
- b. Inventory Report of the same goods to be submitted every week thereafter using the same template (**Annex A**); and
- c. Inventory List as of date of all foreign goods for transshipment that failed to be laden/stuffed in the exporting means of transport within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of arrival pursuant to Section 4.2 of CAO No. 12-2019 and every week thereafter using attached template (**Annex B**).

Aforesaid reports/inventory lists shall be submitted electronically to pocd@customs.gov.ph.
