1.0 Reference:

1.1 CMO No. 24-2018

2.0 Under the cited CMO, CIIS and ESS personnel assigned or deployed to the various Ports/Districts are placed under the operational control of the latter. Hence, supervision and authority over the said personnel is with the District Collectors.

3.0 Even under the CMTA, your duties and responsibilities involve not only ensuring collection of lawful revenues but entails adopting measures to strengthen border control, such as orchestrating intelligence efforts to arrest smuggling. In this regard, you are hereby directed to regularly coordinate with your respective CIIS Field Stations Chiefs for the said purpose.
