VALUE VERIFICATION OF AUTOMOBILES

- 1. Effective 16 June 2014, you are hereby directed to refer to the Imports & Assessment Service (IAS) all entries of shipments covering completely built automobiles with AHTN Headings 87.02 & 87.03 that are propelled by gasoline, diesel, electricity, or any other motive power with engine displacement of 2,000 cc and above.
- 2. No release of shipments of automobiles under these tariff headings should be made without prior clearance from IAS.
- 3. The Import Assessment Service (IAS) will provide value recommendations to the Formal Entry Division (FED) or equivalent units.
- 4. <u>Exclusions from coverage of this Memorandum Circular:</u> This order excludes the following:
 - a. automobile shipments of Chamber of Automotive Manufacturers of the Philippines Incorporated (CAMPI) and Association of Vehicle Importers and Distributors (AVID) members.
 - b. all shipments of buses, trucks, cargo vans, jeepneys/jeepney substitutes, single cab chassis, and special purpose vehicles.
- 5. Proofs of Payment submitted shall be subjected to post-entry audit and verification with our commercial trade attaché in the country of origin.
