

This is to inform that this Department has been invited by the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) to nominate candidates for the above-mentioned award.

The Nakasone Yasuhiro Award is intended to honor meaningful achievements in the political, economic, cultural, and science and technology fields and to encourage further endeavors which will contribute to peace and prosperity in the international community.

Candidates with demonstrated exemplary research or activity in the following fields are encouraged to apply:

1. Enhancing peace and security in the international community
2. Promotion of international economic development and cooperation
3. Activities to support international exchange in culture and arts as well as cultural cooperation
4. International joint research and international collaboration in the fields of science and technology
5. Efforts in such global issues as the environment, energy, medicine, poverty, etc.

Eligible applicants are from Japan and the Asia-Pacific region who are around the age of 45 or younger.

The Institute for International Policy Studies (IIPS) Selection Committee reviews the applications, both self-nominees and referrals from specialists, and makes awards selections.

The required documents are: (1) a detailed description of the subject project in English (maximum 2,500 words) or Japanese (maximum 5,000 characters) to be accompanied by supporting evidence of the subject project, and (2) full name, address, age, nationality, curriculum vitae, place of employment, contact information (telephone, facsimile, email) and recommendations from two references. Please note that the documents will not be returned to the applicant.

Successful awardees will receive an Award of Excellence plaque accompanied by 1,000,000 yen or Incentive Award plaque accompanied by 500,000 yen.
