CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER
NO. 24-90

To: All Collectors of Customs
Service Chiefs

As a requirement in the implementation of Customs Administrative Order No. 3-78, the following instructions are hereby issued:

1. The issuance of Certificate of Qualification under Section II of the Administrative Order shall require the prior inspection of the applicant's premises where the work or processing will be performed.

Photographs showing the interior and exterior of the place as well as that of the machineries and equipment which will be used in the processing shall be submitted or be made by a Customs Inspection Team, which shall be created in the following manner:

- 1.1 For the Port of Manila, Manila International Container Port and the Ninoy Aquino International Airport, an Inspection Team is hereby created composed of the following:

Agt. Ranier Ragos	- CIIS	- Member
Mr. Zosimo Ver	- Cuscom Office	- Member

- 1.2 For outports, the District Collector of Customs is hereby authorized to create its own Inspection Team furnishing the Office of the Commissioner with a list of its composition.

2. Before conducting an inspection, a Mission Order shall first be secured, as follows:
 - 2.1 For Metro ports, the Mission Order shall be issued by the Chief Tax Exempt Division.
 - 2.2 For outports, the Mission Order shall be issued by the District Collector of the Port concerned.
3. The Certificate of Inspection by the Inspection Team, and a Certificate of Appearance executed by the owner/applicant shall form part of the application for CO.

Any violation of the provisions of this Order shall be proceeded against in accordance with Section 7 CAO 3-78.

Customs Memorandum Order Nos. 12-90 and 16-90 are hereby revoked.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
