The Senior Executives Class is a compact course on public management delivered in 2-week segments per month for four months. It features a total of 34 days intensive residential training at the Development Academy of the Philippines Conference Center in Tagaytay City, a 5-day Sensing Journey in rural community and a 5-day Foreign Study Mission in an ASEAN-member country.
