Order No. 31-2011 for strict compliance by all
concerned

All concerned are hereby enjoined to strictly comply with 2.3 of Customs Memorandum Order No. 31-2011 which apparently have not been properly observed since its issuance, quoted to wit:

"To properly monitor the valuation and tariff classification of imported goods and for purposes of building the database of value information and classification, all District/Port Collectors are hereby directed to submit to the Office of the Director, IAS, all import documents, including the accompanying invoices and other commercial and shipping documents, whether the goods were entered under consumption or warehousing or destined to Freeports or special economic zones." (underscoring supplied)
