Appeals Committee II

Objective:

To provide a venue for the speedy and expeditious resolution of all complaints/questions against reports/findings of the SGS on classification.

II. Organization:

There is hereby created a BOC-SGS Appeals Comittee under the office of the COmmissioner which shall be headed by Deputy Commissioner Julieta S. Manahan with the following members:

- 1. Director, Legal Service, or his representative
- 2. Deputy Collector for Assessment, POM or his representative
- 3. Deputy Collector for Assessment, MICP or his representative
- 4. Deputy Collector for Assessment, NAIA or his representative

- 5. Representative of the PCCI6. Representative of the SGS7. Representative of the Tariff Commission

II. Jurisdiction

The committee shall have jurisdiction over all questions/disputes arising from SGS classification as reported in the SGS-CRF.

III. Powers and Duties.

The Committee shall exercise the following powers and duties:

- To meet regularly at least twice a week to study, evaluate and deliberate all complaints against the findings/reports of the SGS on classification as reflected in the Clean Report of Findings (CRF).
- To summon parties for clarificatory guestions, as the need arises.
- 3. To resolve all complaints/guestions on classification for the Commissioner of Customs and to transmit its resolutions to the District Collector concerned for implementation.

IV. Repealing Clause.

This order repeals CMO 12-96, 12-96A. 12-96B and 12-96C.

V. Effectivity.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
