CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 10-2007

SUBJECT:

IMPORTATIONS OF SODIUM TRIPOLYPHOSPHATE

Due to the continued practice of processing of such shipments through the Super Green Lane (SGL) Facility despite the issuance of directives disallowing the practice, the above-mentioned offices are enjoined to immediately update the Automated Customs Operating System (ACOS) to eliminate the risk sought to be addressed by CMO No. 11-2004.

After noting that there was a failure to implement the check and balance mechanism provided in the said CMO, you are expected to extend your full cooperation and support to the Chairman of the Super Green Lane Committee in protecting the integrity of the SGL program by submitting to the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, AOCG a complete and detailed listing of SGL shipments aside from STPP, suspected of having the same/similar risk to enable the said Committee to conduct simultaneous hearings in accordance with Section 8.2 of CMO 28-2003.

Be guided accordingly.
