SUBJECT: Registration of Freight Forwarders, Cargo Consolidators, Breakbulk Agents, and Non-Vessel Operating Common Carriers (NVOCC) with the Philippine Shippers' Council (SHIPPERCON)

Pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 165 dated 31 March 1973 creating the Philippine Shippers' Council, and the Memorandum of Understanding dated 26 June 1991 entered into by and among the (4 6) Mou Bureau of Customs (BOC), the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA), the Civil Aeronautics Board (CAB), and the Philippine Shippers' Council (SHIPPERCON) requiring the registration of freight forwarders, NVOCCs, cargo consolidators and breakbulk agents with the SHIPPERCON, published on 02 July 1991 in the Chronicle, and on 03 July 1991 in the Business Star, as well as the Implementing Rules and Regulations issued by the Philippine Shippers' Council published on 11 November 1991 in the Chronicle, and the amendments thereto published on 13 April Business Star, it is hereby directed that no transaction involving any freight forwarder, NVOCC, cargo consolidator, agent shall be honored/processed in the Bureau breakbulk Customs unless a valid Certificate of Registration issued by the SHIPPERCON has been duly submitted by the aforementioned entities to the Entry Processing Division (EPD) and the Export Division of the port of entry.

Any other customs memoranda, orders, or issuances contrary hereto are hereby deemed revoked or modified accordingly.

This Order shall take effect on 01 June 1992.
