



¹ IQOS – a pen-shaped and comes with an iPod like charger, vaporizes mini tobacco sticks by heating them. The IQOS smokeless cigarette looks a lot like a second generation vaporizer, but is very different from modern electronic cigarettes in terms of functionality. Instead of nicotine-laced e-liquid, it uses actual tobacco in the shape of small cigarettes that are heated at high temperatures but are not burned.
