TO: ALL DEPUTY COMMISSIONERS ALL DIRECTORS & CHIEFS ALL DISTRICT/PORT COLLECTORS AND ALL OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT: Exemption of Imported Lithium Ion Batteries from PDEA Certificate of Exemption Requirement

Pursuant to Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB) Resolution No. 01-2015 (effective on 13 March 2015), imported lithium ion battery packs that are finished products, and which are used as power source for electronic devices, are exempt from the requirement of PDEA Certificate of Exemption. Accordingly, shipments of imported lithium ion batteries can be processed by the Formal Entry Division without the submission of a Certificate of Exemption.
