Subject: Amendment of CMO 44-90 on Overtime at the Piers

Effective immediately, the processing and release of shipments shall be done only during office hours. Overtime work at the piers in all ports of entry may however be authorized under the following rules:

- For shipments duly certified to by the appraiser in charge to be highly perishable and government importations urgently needed for infrastructure or similar purpose, overtime work may be allowed at any time, including Sundays.
- For all other importations, overtime work shall only be allowed from Monday until 5:00 p.m. Saturday.
- 3. No overtime work shall be allowed for the release of the following shipments:
  - 3.1 Cargoes previously alerted or under hold order
  - 3.2 Consolidated shipments
  - 3.3 Personal Effects
  - .4 Motor Vehicle parts (used)
  - 3.5. Similar sensitive commodities/articles that may be listed/classified by the Collector of Customs of the Commissioner of Customs from time to time.
- 4. All requests for overtime shall be filed not later than 4:00 p.m. during office hours.
- 5. No overtime application shall be processed unless endorsed by the customs examiner concerned who shall certify as to the contents of the cargo.

This Order modifies Customs Memorandum Order No. 44-90.
