SUBJECT: Clarification of Section 1 of

CMO No. 46-90.

In response to the inquiries by EPZA-Registered Zone Enterprises (EZRE) regarding the requirement of filing a warehousing entry for all importations intended for EZRE as provided in Section 1 of CMO No. 46-90 dated July 18, 1990, it should be made clear to all concerned that the said requirement of a warehousing entry is intended to replace the practice of filing a mere tally sheet for EZRE importations but not to take away the incentives enjoyed by EZRE under Presidential Decree No. 66, as amended. Accordingly, EZRE importations shall be covered by a warehousing entry but without the need of a warehousing bond as required in other warehousing entries. For purposes of identification, the Transhipment Permit and the Warehousing Permit shall be stamped "EZRE Importation".
