Subject: Alleged Fake/Fabricated NFA Import Permits/IPs Validity Period of only 15 Calendar Days

Attached is the letter dated January 30, 2018 of Lt. Col. Jason L.Y. Aquino (Ret.) PA, Administrator, National Food Authority (NFA) regarding the alleged fake/fabricated Import Permits issued in the name of the **Philippine International Trading Corporation (PITC)** being circulated with details as follows:

NFA informs that the **PITC** did not apply for an import allocation under the 2017 Minimum Access Volume (MAV) Rice Import Program. Thus, they did not issue any of the above mentioned Import Permits.

Also, NFA informs that as per NFA Council-approved Guidelines, the Import Permits under the 2017 MAV Rice Importation Program has a validity of only fifteen (15) calendar days from the date of issuance and not one (1) year as specified in these spurious Import Permits.





Please be informed that the PITC did not apply for an import allocation under the 2017 Minimum Access Volume (MAV) Rice Importation Program. Thus, the National Food Authority (NFA) did not issue any of the above mentioned Import Permits. The Import Permit form of the NFA is an accountable form with security features inscribed and imbedded on it.

Also, based on the NFA Council-approved Guidelines, the Import Permit under the 2017 MAV Rice Importation Program has a validity period of only fifteen (15) calendar days from the date of issuance and not for one (1) year as specified in these spurious Import Permits.
