Cuñado, Director, Environmental Management Bureau, Department of Environment and Natural Resources (EMB-DENR) addressed to Ms. RAQUEL D. 

This has reference to your letter (IIS Transaction No.: CO-2022-035590) dated 12 September 2022 inquiring the requirements for the export of chemicals such as unexpired S-Nickel Pellets (20 boxes/400 kilograms) and expired Nickel Chloride (50 bags/500 kilograms) to Japan for the purpose of returning to vendor (Shimizu Tokenzai Co., Ltd.).

In this regard, please be informed that we interpose no objection to the proposed export provided that it shall be limited to the declared types and quantities of material.
