DATE : 21 December 2022

With reference to the Announcement of the Strategic Trade Management Office of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI-STMO) dated 08 August 2022, please be informed that **starting 01 January 2023, the export of strategic goods without duly signed authorization issued by the STMO shall no longer be allowed.**

The STMO further encourages all persons engaged in the export of strategic goods to register and apply for authorization before engaging in any of the regulated activities, taking into consideration the processing time prescribed by the Strategic Trade Management Act (STMA) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

Failure to comply with the prescribed authorization requirements will lead to the imposition of administrative or criminal penalties under the STMA.
