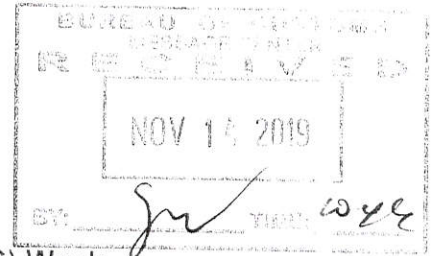

SUBJECT : Drug Abuse Prevention and Control (DAPC) Week



Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 124, series of 2001, the Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB) is spearheading the nationwide observance of the Drug Abuse Prevention and Control (DAPC) Week with the theme "Katarungan para sa Kalusugan, Kalusugan para sa Katarungan" from 17 to 23 November 2019. This event will be observed simultaneously by participating Local Government Units nationwide.

The Kick-off ceremonies will be held at the EMR Center, Koronadal City on 18 November 2019 (Monday). The program will include caravan, motorcade, press conference, launching of Drug Abuse Prevention Campaign for Indigenous People (IP) Communities, awarding of Outstanding CADAC/MADAC and Program Implementors of the province, and holding of various competitions to be participated by different schools and barangays from the Province of South Cotabato. Prizes await the winners, including the biggest and most colorful delegations.

In this connection, DDB is respectfully requesting to undertake activities which are geared towards the attainment of their goals by way of promoting the event and the campaign message through:

- Putting-up streamers/banners in strategic places in your agency (see attached template);
- Posting of the event and its theme on your electronic billboard (if any);
- Participation of your staff along with many advocates of your locality during the kick-off ceremonies. The food, transportation and other incidental expenses shall be borne by your agency.
