Writs of Preliminary Injunction on The New Technical Regulations Concerning the Mandatory Certification of Flat Glass, Heat-Strengthened and Fully Tempered Glass, Laminated Glass and Laminated Safety Glass in Building and Bent Glass.

With reference to the attached letter dated October 7, 2019 from Neil P. Catajay, Officer-in-Charge, Bureau of Product Standard (BPS), all concerned are informed regarding the issuance of Writs of Preliminary Injunction by the Regional Trial Courts Branch 141-Makati City and Branch 108-Pasay City on the implementation of Department Administrative Order (DAO) 19-05 Series of 2019 or **The New Technical Regulations Concerning the Mandatory Certification of Flat Glass, Heat-Strengthened and Fully Tempered Glass, Laminated Glass and Laminated Safety Glass in Building and Bent Glass.**

Relative thereto, imported products covered under the aforesaid DAO are not required to undergo the mandatory certification process from the BPS. Finally, the aforesaid products may be released without BPS certification, subject to BOC's Rules and Regulations.


We will advise you accordingly for any further developments on this issue.
