The Accreditation Committee under CMO 30-91 that accredits importers availing of the EPRS System is hereby reconstituted whose functions shall include the accreditation of Garment Exporters exempting them from the SGS pre-shipment inspection pursuant to Section 5 of CMO 30-93.

Deputy Commissioner, Assessment & Operations Group - Chairman - Vice Chairman Chief, Import Assessment Service - Member District Collector of the Port Concerned - Member Chief, Legal Service Chief, Customs Intelligence & Investigation Service Chief, Enforcement & Sercurity Service - Member - Member - Member Chief, Collection Monitoring Service

The Committee shall have the following functions:

To evaluate application for certificate of accreditation under the EPRS and exemption from SGS pre-shipment inspection garment exporters.

2. To receive and, investigate information adverse to the application

and/or consider evidence in opposition thereto.

This Order shall take effect upon approval by the Commissioner of Customs.
