CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 5-96

Implementation of <u>CAO 9-92</u> in imposing fees on request for Circularization of Trademark Registration and/or Patents and Other Similar Request

TO: All Customs Officials & Employees and Private Entities Concerned

It is noted that there are several requests for the circularization of trademark registration and/or patent without regard to payment of the rightful fees required under the above-captioned administrative order which was issued September 21, 1992.

In compliance, therefore, no request for circularization or issuance of a Customs Memorandum Circular from any private individual or entity shall be entertained without first paying the required fee of Five Hundred Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}500.00)\$ through the Collection Service. All original copies of the CMC on file at the Central Records Management Office shall have the duplicate (green) copy of the Customs Official Receipt as proof of payment.

A copy of this order shall be forwarded to the Customs COA Auditor for audit of compliance.

All concerned shall be guided accordingly.
