This concerns the imposition of the price-based, Special Safeguards (SSG) Duty on the importation of chicken and chicken products pursuant to DA Department Order No. 4 dated 25 September 2002 and Customs Memorandum Order No. 42 dated 21 November 2002.

We have catablished, in consultation with the industry, that there may be a shortage in the supply of chicken in the coming months. This came about because of some production reduction measures done by industry in February and March due to the Avian Influenza-scare and the surge in demand in April and May. These have contributed to increased prices.






IMPOSITION OF SPECIAL SAFEGUARD DUTY ON CHICKEN IMPORTS

Pursuant to Republic Act 8800, referred to as the Safeguard Measures Act (chapter III, sections 21 and 23), we are requesting for the imposition of special safeguard (SSG) duty on chicken products eligible for SSG measure as follows:

A. Imposition of price-based SSG duty

As shown, it is requested that additional duty be imposed for five (5) chicken products which are eligible for SSG because their respective trigger prices have been breached or that the actual c.i.f. import price of each product is less than its corresponding trigger price. The amount of SSG duty to be imposed shall be on a shipment-by-shipment basis and shall depend on the difference between the c.i.f. import price and the product's trigger price as illustrated in the example provided in Annex A.

HS CODE (2001)	Product Description	Regular out-quota customs duty (2002)	SSG duty to be imposed

For "meat and offal of fowls of the species Gallus domesticus, prepared or preserved in airtight containers" or chicken product with HS code 1602.3210, SSG duty is requested to be imposed because its trigger volume has been breached or that its currorative import volume for year 2002 has already exceeded its trigger volume. The amount of SSG duty to be imposed shall be 15% or one third of the applicable out-quota customs duty (chapter III, rule 23.1 b of RA 8800) Further, this SSG duty is requested to be made effective immediately but up to the end of the year only.

May we further request that the imposition of the SSG duty on the specified chicken products be made effective immediately.
