Subject: ***DIRECT TRADER INPUT (DTI) TRANSACTION FEE***

Due to the recent acquisition of equipment and communication facilities, electronic entries lodged and processed through the DTI system will now be charged with P30 transaction fee starting June 15, 1998 in line with the Memorandum of Agreement entered into by the DTI Client and the Bureau of Customs.

This is to make DTI in equal footing with Entry Encoding Center (EEC) and with the Electronic Data Interchange (EDI).

This is also to generate adequate funds for the establishment and maintenance of DTI facilities.
