Name-Dropping by Individuals/Entities Claiming Relationship with the Commissioner of Customs.

The public is cautioned not to entertain any individual or entity following up papers/documents or entering into any form of transaction with the Bureau of Customs using the name of the Commissioner of Customs, any member of his family and friends, for the purpose of influencing the action of Customs officials or employees on matters pending before their respective offices or to expedite the release of shipments covered thereby.

All Customs personnel are hereby instructed to refrain from giving special treatments to shipments or any customs matter being processed or followed-up by persons or companies claiming actual or alleged relationship with the Commissioner of Customs and to report to his office any transaction/shipment where his name or that of any member of his family or friends is being name-dropped for institution of the appropriate sanction/s.
