## CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER NO.

tasked with the duties of obtaining sufficient descriptions of all said vehicles thru proper documentation; determine their respective status, and to continuously coordinate with all offices to expedite actions prepa-

ratory to the disposal thereof. In the performances of its functions, the Committee is hereby empowered to demand production of documents/papers from any or all offices of the Bureau of Customs, and other offices, and for the purpose may issue subpoena and/or subpoena duces tecum.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall last until revoked.
