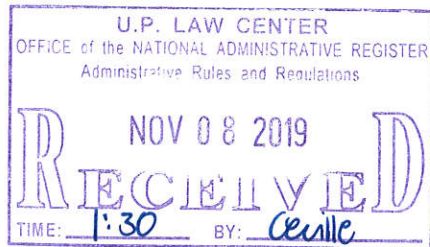



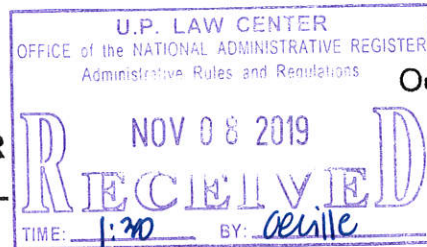

**CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER**  
NO. 49-2019

**SUBJECT: MANDATORY FILLING-UP OF BOX NO. 41 (SUPPLEMENTAL UNITS)  
IN THE LODGEMENT OF THE GOODS DECLARATION IN THE E2M**

1. **OBJECTIVES.** This order is issued for the following purposes:
  - 1.1 To enhance the capability and effectiveness of the Bureau of Customs (BOC) in monitoring all importations by requiring declarants to completely and properly fill-out the supplemental units in the goods declaration;
  - 1.2 To provide for the specific guidelines in properly accomplishing the supplemental units under Box. No. 41 of the goods declaration in the e2m;
  - 1.3 To establish a database of transaction values that are at par with the internationally accepted standards on units of measurement to facilitate collection, comparison and analysis of international statistics based on the Harmonized System; and
  - 1.4 To properly assess and collect duties and taxes on imported articles.
2. **SCOPE/COVERAGE.** This order shall cover lodgment of goods declaration under consumption entry (formal and informal) for HS codes mentioned in the attached Annex "A" of this memorandum.
3. **DEFINITION OF TERMS.** For the purposes of this CMO, the following terms are defined accordingly:
  - 3.1 **ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN)** – refers to the 8-digit nomenclature, consisting of the latest version of the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (hereinafter referred to as "HS CODE") of the World Customs Organization and the amendments thereto, with the addition of the seventh and eight digits and commodity description for tariff purposes (the seventh and eight digits and commodity description hereinafter referred to as "ASEAN subheadings").
  - 3.2 **Box 41 of Goods Declaration in E2M** – refers to the supplemental units of the Goods Declaration in the Electronic to Mobile system (e2m).

- 3.3 **Declarant** – refers to a consignee or a person who has the right to dispose of the goods. The declarant shall lodge a goods declaration with the Bureau and may be:
- a.) The importer, being the holder of the bill of lading; or
  - b.) The exporter, being the owner of the goods to be shipped out; or
  - c.) A customs broker acting under the authority of the importer or from a holder of the bill; or
  - d.) A person duly empowered to act as agent or attorney-in-fact for each holder.
- 3.5 **Goods Declaration** – refers to a statement made in the manner prescribed by the Bureau and other appropriate agencies, by which the person concerned, indicate the procedure to be observed in the application for the entry or admission of imported goods and the particulars of which the customs administration shall require.
- 3.6 **Pieces (PCE)** – refers to a unit of measurement for number equivalent to an individual object or item regarded as a unit of a kind or class.
- 3.7 **Units** – within the context of this memorandum, units shall have the same meaning as pieces.


#### 4. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

- 4.1 The Imports and Assessment Service (IAS) under the Assessment and Operations Coordinating Group (AOCG) shall be the office directly in charge with the implementation of this Order.
- 4.2 The IAS shall be provided with sufficient access to the E2M Customs System and other statistical extraction tools necessary to effectively carry out its mandate under this Order.

#### 5. OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES

- 5.1 For purposes of this memorandum, the mandatory requirement of filling out Box No. 41 of the goods declaration shall cover the chapters indicated in the hereto attached Annex "A".
- 5.2 Annex "A" enumerates the commodities under the 6-digits tariff line (HS Code subheading) of the AHTN. This also covers commodities classifiable under the 8-digits tariff line (AHTN subheading) of the same 6-digits tariff line (HS Code subheading).

- 5.3 The MISTG shall ensure that "PCE" shall be automatically reflected as the unit of measurement in Box No. 41 of the goods declaration based on the attached Annex "A" and that the lodging of entries shall only be accepted by the system once the supplemental unit has been filled out by the declarant.
  - 5.4 The declarant shall be responsible in the proper and accurate lodgment of the supplemental unit or the total numbers of pieces indicated in Box no. 41.
  - 5.5 The concerned Formal and Informal Entry Division or equivalent assessment unit shall see to it that the declaration on the supplemental unit of goods declaration corresponds to the correct number of the imported goods as verified from the attached shipping documents such as packing list and Bill of Lading, among others. In case of error/discrepancy in the declaration, the concerned customs examiner shall update the goods declaration accordingly to reflect the correct number of units.
  - 5.6 In case of multiple commodities falling under a similar tariff heading, the declaration shall be itemized per commodity description. Therefore, commodities shall be declared individually depending on the number of commodities on the attached rider of the goods declaration.
  - 5.7 The assessment of goods per piece shall be computed by multiplying the customs value with the number declared in the Box No. 41 of the e2m goods declaration. For example, if a certain commodity has a customs value of \$10.00, and the specific number indicated in Box No. 41 is 100, the resulting total customs value shall be at \$1,000.00.
6. **SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any part of this CMO is declared unconstitutional or contrary to existing laws, other parts not so declared shall remain in full force or effect.
  7. **REPEALING CLAUSE.** All CMOs and Memoranda issued contrary to this Order are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.
  8. **PENAL PROVISIONS.** Failure to comply with any provision of this memorandum shall be penalized accordingly pursuant to existing rules and regulations.
  9. **EFFECTIVITY.** This Order shall take effect immediately fifteen (15) days after the completion of its publication.


