Please be informed that the importation and export of the said materials are not covered by Chapter 10 of DENR Administrative Order (DAO) No. 2013-22: Revised Procedures and Standards for the Management of Hazardous Wastes (Revising DAO 2004-36).

In this regard, Importation and Export Clearances are not required from this Bureau. However, this does not preclude you from complying with the requirements of other government agencies that have mandate or jurisdiction regulating the same.
