Pursuant to Customs Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 34-2009, the Warehouse Coordination Division (WCD) is tasked to ensure that the rules and regulations on Customs Bonded Warehouse (CBW) are properly implemented thru effective coordination, evaluation, supervision and monitoring of relevant policies and guidelines.

Relative thereto, all Warehouse Operating Divisions or its equivalent unit in all Ports are directed to furnish certified true copies of reports of Statement of Full Liquidation of CBWs under their jurisdiction covering the period of three (3) years from 2019 to 2021 addressed to the Office of the Warehouse Coordination Division. You are given fifteen (15) days upon receipt to submit the said documents.
