

"IN RE: SUBMISSION OF UPDATED CLEARANCES AND STATEMENT OF LIQUIDATION."

Resolution No. 150-2021

RESOLUTION

This has reference to the mandate of the Customs Bonded Warehouse Committee (CBWC) under Section 5.1.10 of Customs Administrative Order (CAO) No. 13-2019 to evaluate, review and consolidate all applications for the establishment and/or renewal of CBW and other related matters pertaining to the operations of CBW, with the following information gathered during the Customs Bonded Warehouse Committee's (CBWC) regular meeting held on 21 of October 2021:

WHEREAS, during series of deliberations of the CBWC, the members of CBWC observed these deficiencies relative to the submitted applications for renewal of Authority to Operate of CBWs, to wit:

- a. that the clearances attached to some applications for renewal of CBWs emanating from the District Collectors are not up to date; and
- b. that the clearance certifying in general terms that CBW "has no outstanding or unsettled accountability nor pending case filed against the entity" is insufficient to fully establish proper liquidation of all warehousing entries filed one year immediately preceding the filing of the renewal of Authority to Operate:

WHEREAS, in aid of the CBWC's function and in order to fully exercise its mandate under Section 5.1.10 of CAO 13-2019 of evaluating and reviewing applications for renewal of Authority to Operate of CBWs and other related matters, the abovementioned deficiencies must be addressed.

For and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the CBWC, in their regular meeting on 21 October 2021, APPROVED the submission of the following additional documents for the purpose of evaluation and review of application for renewal of Authority to Operate of CBWs and other related matters, to wit:

- 1. Updated Clearances issued within three (3) months immediately preceding the filing of renewal of Authority to Operate before the office of the District Collector;
- 2. Certificate of No Pending Accountability from the Account Officer and Warehouseman with attached Statement of Liquidation covering warehousing entries filed one year immediately preceding the filing of renewal of Authority to Operate before the office of the District Collector:
